WHAT IS IT?

The goal of the [Legal Scholarship Network](#) (LSN) is to facilitate the distribution of scholarly information related to law for legal, economics, business scholars, and practitioners throughout the world. LSN relies on authors or researchers in the legal community to submit bibliographic/abstract information about their work. LSN is a division of Social Science Research Network (SSRN). Other SSRN divisions include Economics, Management, Financial Economics, and Accounting.

WHAT DOES IT CONTAIN?

LSN publishes a broad series of email abstracting journals of working papers and articles accepted for publication. Among the many journals included are the *Virginia Law Review*, *Iowa Law Review*, and the *Delaware Journal of Corporate Law*.

In addition to including abstracts of scholarly papers, LSN also publishes weekly professional announcements that include announcements such as important professional meetings, calls for papers and special issues of journals, and professional job listings that carry announcements of open positions in academia and industry.

HOW DO I ACCESS LSN?

- LSN is available at <http://www.ssrn.com/lsn/index.html>. Our site license allows faculty to search the database and establish a journal subscription service to receive email updates. These updates abstract working papers and/or articles accepted for publication.
- To subscribe click on the “Subscribe” tab at the top of the LSN homepage and then select “Legal Scholarship Network Site Licenses.”
- Select “Catholic University” from the list of law schools and then enter your e-mail address in the new window. A password will be e-mailed to new subscribers enabling them to enter the database.
- Once the e-mail address and password have been entered the user can either select which journals they wish to subscribe to from a list of journals, or search the database for articles on a particular topic or by a particular author.

HOW DO I SUBMIT AN ARTICLE TO LSN?

LSN also provides an Online Submission System that allows authors to submit and revise abstracts and full-text papers in PDF format. No fee is charged for the submission of abstracts and papers for inclusion in the LSN e-Library and publication in email journals. Authors are encouraged to submit all their working paper and accepted paper abstracts and papers.
